

ORDINANCE NO. 07-01

PROTECTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM OBSTRUCTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dasher, and it is hereby ordained by authority thereof as follows:

(a) No person shall cause, either directly or indirectly, any object to be placed upon any street, highway, bridge, alley, driveway, road or other passageway within the city, normally and customarily utilized in whole or in part for the movement of motor vehicular traffic, which obstructs, retards, or tends to obstruct or retard the movement of vehicular traffic thereon, or which has the potential to damage vehicles which travel thereon or to harm the occupants of such vehicles.

(b) No person shall intentionally obstruct the free, convenient and normal use of any public sidewalk, street, highway, bridge, alley, road or other passageway, or the entrance, exit, corridor or other passageway to or from any building or structure adjacent thereto by impeding, hindering, blocking, retarding, delaying or detaining vehicular or pedestrian traffic thereon; provided, however, that this subsection shall not be construed to punish handbilling or soliciting for any lawful purpose by isolated individuals, unless conducted in a manner that in fact impedes, blocks, delay, or detains pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

The above restrictions shall not apply where owners of existing buildings have provided access to said buildings for handicapped persons, in the form of a ramp, not more than thirty-six (36) inches wide and parallel to the right-of-way; provided that the area from the back of the curb to the right-of-way is a distance of six (6) feet or more. This exception for handicap ramps shall be subject to the approval by the city.
