ORDINANCE NO. 98-4

DISPOSING OF REFUSE AND GARBAGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the mayor and council of the City of Dasher, Georgia, and it is hereby ORDAINED by authority of same, as follows:

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to dump or cause to be dumped any garbage, refuse, litter, junk, appliances, equipment, cans, bottles, paper, lumber, trees, tree limbs, brush or parts thereof anywhere, other than upon that person's property, and also in or immediately adjacent to garbage/refuse containers designed and used for regular garbage/refuse collection and disposal.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to dump or cause to be dumped or buried on any private property of another or on city property, any of the materials described in subsection (a).

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to burn, or cause to be burned, garbage, heavy oils, asphaltic materials, items containing natural or synthetic rubber or any material other than plant growth. No open burning shall be in violation of Chapter 391-3-1 of the Georgia department of natural resources environmental protection division regulations under the Air Quality Control Act.


(d) It shall be unlawful for any person to remove waste or litter from public containers or to place in such containers any material other than garbage.

(e) The provisions of subsections (a) and (b) do not apply to the dumping on private property with the owner's permission of sand, dirt, broken brick, blocks or broken pavement or other suitable material for use as a fill to raise the elevation of the land, provided the same is not maintained in any unsightly condition and provided the owners of the property on which such material is dumped agree to level such dumped material with appropriate grading equipment, and to cover it with dirt, upon direction of the appropriate city official or designee or county manager of Lowndes County, or in lieu thereof, agree to permit the city or Lowndes County to level and cover said material so dumped with appropriate grading equipment and assess the cost thereof against the real property on which such material is dumped.



(f) No sanitary landfill or dump shall be operated within the city, without the written approval of the mayor/council or designee and of the Environmental Protection Division of the State of Georgia, Department of Natural Resources.
