

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR 1999 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF DASHER


BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council and the City of Dasher, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by authority of same, in accordance with the Georgia Municipal Election Code, as amended, Title 21, Chapter 3, O.C.G.A.:

1. A non-partisan general election for the City of Dasher shall be held on the 2nd day of November 1999 for the purpose of electing a Councilperson for District 3 and district 4. Said terms to expire December 31, 2003.
2. Richard Hamlen shall be superintendent of said election. The Superintendent shall be employed. Betty Scruggs, Chairman of the Lowndes County Board of Elections, shall serve as Municipal Registrar.
3. Superintendent of Elections shall be authorized and is hereby granted approval to hire Lowndes County Board of Elections to conduct said election.
4. The Superintendent is granted approval to employ the Absentee Ballot clerk, Voting Machine Custodian, Administrative clerk, and clerks as needed to accompany the voting tables for the said election. Michelle Beck, of the Lowndes County Board of Elections shall serve as absentee ballot clerk.
5. Candidates in said election shall qualify with a Superintendent of said election in the Dasher City Hall between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. from September 13, 1999, through September 15, 1999.
6. Qualifying fees for the office of councilman shall be \$35.00. In lieu of qualifying fees, a pauper's affidavit as provided for in accordance with Section 21-3-90 of the O.C.G.A. may be filed.
7. Absentee voting shall be permitted in accordance with the provisions of the Charter and the Georgia Municipal Election Code, the provision of which code shall in all events prevail in cases of conflict.
8. Notice of said election shall be published as required by law.

9. In the event a run-off election is necessary to be held as provided by law, the same shall be held on the 23rd day of November 1999, under all conditions required by law and at the polling places provided for the conduct of the General Elections.

10. Registration for voters desiring to vote in said election shall cease October 4, 1999.
